

Dutchess Land Conservancy Stewardship Internship Description

Title: Stewardship Internship

Location: 4289 Route 82, Millbrook, NY

Duration: Approximately 3-4 months. May to September. Start and end dates are flexible. Approximately

21-28 hrs./week.

Compensation: This is a paid internship position. Housing will not be available.

The *Stewardship Intern*, under the direct supervision of the *Stewardship Associate*, is responsible for working with the Stewardship staff to meet their yearly goals.

Responsibilities Include:

- Extensive fieldwork involving monitoring of conservation easement-protected properties.
- Hiking off-trail over a variety of terrains to document the condition of the property in photographs and writing.
- Using photo-editing and GIS software to complete ground monitoring reports with associated maps and photographs.
- Monitoring the current property condition, noting possible changes including construction of buildings or roads, tree clearing, disturbance of wetlands and waterways, and natural disturbances such as erosion.
- Scanning and filing, reports.

Recommended Qualifications:

- Excellent interpersonal and organizational skills.
- Background in Adobe Photoshop and ArcGIS (specific training will be provided.)
- Detail-oriented and self-motivated.
- Drivers license and personal vehicle.
- Ability to navigate using maps, aerial photographs, and GPS.
- Coursework in environmental science, environmental studies, biology, or related fields.
- Applicant should be in good physical condition and able to hike over rough terrain.
